There are also 1.5 percent more rooms available in Louisiana this year. Nationwide room demand is 1.6% higher than last year. Nationwide occupancy is 0.2% higher than last year.

Cruise lines, with an increased number of domestic drive-to ports and sailings, again filled their added capacity, up 10 percent this year. Carribean destination performance was surprisingly strong.
